11. CALCULATION OF MERIT :

The name of the examination should be Higher Secondary (+2) or as mentioned in the Mark-sheet of other recognized Boards or Councils. The total marks obtained should be the aggregate of the best five, where applicable, including First or Second Language or both (as the case may be) but excluding EVS (where it is not an elective subject).

[For example: A student has passed the Higher Secondary Examination with following scores:

Language I- 60

Language II - 81

Political Science - 68

Geography - 82

History - 62

Philosophy (Optional Elective) - 74

EVS - 88 (not an Elective Subject)

Now the calculation of percentage shall be made on the basis of the best five scores, e.g. $\{(82+81+74+68+62)/5\} = 367/5 = 73.4\%$

*For determination of minimum eligibility the Grand Total marks (where applicable) will be converted into percentage. In such cases 500 (five hundred) or 450 (four hundred fifty) (as the case may be) out of 1000 (one thousand) shall mean 50 percent or 45 percent respectively.

Note: In the 'Best Five Norms', EVS, if it is not an Elective Subject, shall not be taken for determination of eligibility or merit.

12. FEES STRUCTURE :

- a. Fees for application is **Rs. 300/- only** and **Rs. 150/- only** for SC/ST/PH.
- b. For Vocational category applicants the application fee is **Rs. 300/- only**
- c. Application fee for In-Service & Ex-Serviceman category seats is Rs. 300/- only.

For J, the name of the examination should be Higher Secondary or as mentioned in the Mark-sheet of other Boards or Councils. The total marks obtained should be the aggregate of the best five including First and Second Language but excluding EVS.

[For example: A student has passed the Higher Secondary Examination with following scores:

- 1st Language – 50
- 2nd Language – 78
- Political Science – 60
- Geography – 55
- History – 70
- Philosophy (Optional Elective) – 90
- EVS – 79

Now the calculation of percentage shall be made on the basis of $(50+78+90+70+60/5) = 69.6\%$.

Note: He/she has scored more marks in Geography, but in order to keep the two language papers for calculation, a better performance (55 in Geography) has to be kept off. Again the number in EVS cannot be taken for calculation.]

Note : For determination of minimum eligibility the Grand Total marks (where applicable) will be converted into percentage. In such cases 500 (five hundred) or 450 (four hundred fifty) (as the case may be) out of 1000 (one thousand) shall mean 50 percent or 45 percent respectively.

For K, applicants should put tick mark (✓) in the appropriate box of category he or she belongs to. They should write 'A' or 'B' in case they belong to **OBC** and also tick (✓) in the same box.

Candidates belonging to Ex-serviceman category should write 'Ex-ser' and tick (✓) against the category.

For L, applicants applying for admission to two-year D. El. Ed. Course may mention their higher qualification, if any. No marks for Higher Qualification.

For M & O, the applicant should put his or her full signature in English.

For N, the applicant should paste his or her recent passport size (3.5 cms. X 4.5 cms.) photograph in the space provided. The photograph should not be stapled or pinned. Attestation of photograph of the applicant must be done by the applicant himself or herself by signing across the photograph at the bottom after it is pasted so that a part of the signature appears outside the photograph.

For the items **G** and **J** above, attestation/certification should be done by a Group 'A' category officer or the Head Master of a recognized high school.

11. Mode of Selection:

- in order of merit on the basis of the percentage of the marks obtained at the Higher Secondary Examination (+2 stage) calculated as per the above example.

12. Course Fee:

- The Course Fee for a Government Institution shall be as per the existing fees structure of the West Bengal Board of Primary Education.
- For the Un-aided Private Institutions it shall be @ Rs. 12,000/- (Rupees twelve thousand) only per quarter in addition to Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees one thousand) only per month as Hostel Fees.

13. Availability of Forms: Information Booklet-cum-Application Form shall be available immediately after the Advertisement/Notification with the Heads of the Institutions (List of the Institutions enclosed) on payment of Rs. 300/- (Rs. 150/- for SC/ST/PH) by cash.
